Project Overview

As part of the Gateshead NHS Foundation Trust, the Queen Elizabeth Hospital is consistently proven to be one of the top hospitals in the country. Works involved the renewal of domestic services including the re-routing of existing drainage to the new layout, installation of LST radiators and new heating pipework and chlorination of all domestic services prior to handover.
